Guest Professor Sophia Mitra will lead the group beginning at **7:30 pm** in Room D. Most discussions last approximately 90 minutes. The 2005 **film** version of the novel - starring Reese Witherspoon - will be shown at **7 pm** on Thursday, **June 2**. The film is free and no sign-up is required. Bring your own popcorn, and a cushion if you find our chairs somewhat less than comfy for the duration of an entire "flick." The film is listed at 2 hours and 20 minutes, not counting a break, so plan on getting out at about 9:30 pm.

All adults are welcome to join any or all of our "**Let's Talk About It**" book discussions. The group is "commitment free" and very flexible, so you can participate as often or as little as you like. (Of course, it would be *much* more fun with *you* there!) Participation is free. Signup is helpful but not required, as long as there is adequate space. Very rarely, if the book being discussed is exceptionally popular and space becomes limited, those who have signed up in advance are admitted first.
