Somerset County Library System Membership Information

To become an active borrower at the Somerset County Library System through its branch libraries in Bound Brook, Bridgewater, Hillsborough, Manville, North Plainfield, Peapack, Rocky Hill, Somerville, Warren and Watchung you must meet one of the following requirements:

- 1. Live, own property, work or go to school in one of the 14 member municipalities. (Raritan Valley Community College students and Somerset County government workers are also eligible).
- 2. Pay an annual fee of \$185.00 to be a member
- 3. Be a literacy volunteer or student using a SCLS facility for tutoring.
- 4. Work in one of our member municipalities.

Also, the Somerset County Library will issue a free library card to Somerset County residents who have a verifiable mental or physical disability.

A special, separate dedicated library tax is paid by the citizens of the fourteen member municipalities of the Somerset County Library System. This tax almost completely funds the system.

General Somerset County funds support some offices within the joint County Headquarters Branch Library in Bridgewater. In return, the Somerset County Library provides a variety of services to all county residents directly and indirectly.

- In-house use of the library materials and computers.
- Small libraries contained in the County Jail and Youth Center.
- Information, research assistance, and interlibrary loan provided to independent libraries in Somerset County.
- Information resources including research databases available 24/7 through the library website, with an internet connection and a library card http://www.sclsnj.org.
- Raritan Valley Community College and Somerset County Vo-Tech students served directly as eligible borrowers and indirectly through the consortium of two libraries (RVCC College Library and Vo-Tech Library).
